Based on love letters author Kristina McMorris's Naval officer grandfather wrote to her grandmother during World War II, this touching story opens at a 1944 USO dance, where infantryman Morgan meets reserved Liz and her gregarious roommates Julia and Betty. After Morgan goes overseas and begins writing to Betty, Liz—who can't get him off her

mind—ghostwrites Betty's responses with her blessing. As

the soldier adjusts to the brutality of war, Liz and Betty struggle to follow the paths society has set for them, while worrying about how Morgan will react when he learns the truth about the letters.
